INSTRUCTIONAL (IN-HOUSE) LEAGUE REGISTRATION

- Any child age 4 by *April 1, 2010* or any child between the ages of 5 and 17 as of *August 1, 2009*. No residency restrictions.
- Registration is \$75.00 per player and includes a team jersey. Register In-person on 1/23 or 1/27 (TWO DAYS ONLY) by cash or check or ON-LINE 1/1 through 2/7 by credit card (No On-line Discount).
- ON-LINE Registration is available FOR INSTRUCTIONAL PLAYERS ONLY. YOU MUST PAY BY CREDIT CARD ONLINE AND AGREE TO ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS. See our website for details.
- Practices begin the week of April 12th, twice a week for approx. 1 hour each (coach picks day & time). Six (6) Games will be played from April 24th through June 5th with no Games Memorial Day Weekend. Games are typically played Saturday mornings through early afternoon. Older age groups may have a week-day game. Individual game times vary each week. **PLEASE NOTE PRACTICE AND GAME LOCATIONS SHOWN BELOW!**
- U6 & U8 practices and games will be at Stephen Park in Schererville; U11 will practice at a separate field in the area (potentially Redar and Foxwood Parks - until the ongoing field development is completed) and play their games at Rohrman Park in Schererville; U14 teams will practice at Patnoe Park in St. John and play their games at Rohrman Park in Schererville; U18 teams will practice and play games at Plum Creek Park in Schererville.

REC-PLUS (TRAVEL) LEAGUE REGISTRATION

- U8, U10, U12, & U14 Boys & Girls between the ages of 6 and 13 as of *August 1, 2009*.
- Registration is \$95.00 per player and ONLY AVAILABLE IN-PERSON on 1/23 or 1/27 (TWO DAYS ONLY) by cash or check. New Travel players must purchase a Schererville Travel uniform for an additional \$45.00.
- **SORRY, DUE TO THE ADDITIONAL PAPERWORK THAT IS NEEDED, ONLINE REGISTRATION IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR REC-PLUS (TRAVEL) PLAYERS.**
- **ALL new Travel players must bring 2 small pictures for ID cards and a copy of their birth certificate to registration.** Practices typically start in April, twice a week for 1 - 1.5 hours each. The season ends in June. Half of the games are played at Rohrman Park and the other half at your opponents. Rec-plus teams compete against other club teams in our area. Teams generally play with the same rosters as the previous season, filling openings as needed. Any coaching conflicts must be brought up prior to the end of registration. The number of teams and players-per-team are subject to available openings and Northwest Indiana Soccer League rules.
- As an additional benefit for our Travel teams, a professional trainer from Challenger Sports will be scheduled to work with each team on a rotating basis throughout the Spring season.
